4. Abstract (limit to 250 words) please note that abstracts will be condensed for publishing.
5. Learning Objectives: List at least 3.
6. Lead Presenter experience: Describe your expertise in the topic area, relevant experience and/or previous presentations at NCAPT or APT (or other professional organizations).
7. Audio Visual Requirements – LCD projectors/screens are provided. You will need to bring your own laptop. VCR, DVD player and TV are available upon request.
